Minimum requirements:

1. The house must be located in Camden County, Currituck County, Dare County, Hyde County or Pasquotank County.
2. An owner of the house must live in the house.
3. An occupant of the house must be over 62 years old, disabled, or a veteran, or the house must contain lead paint hazards with children under 7years old.

The household income must be less than the amounts listed below :

General Information

1. The program can spend up to \$25,000 on one home.
2. The funds will be in the form of a **forgiven**, deferred payment loan.
3. The house must meet minimum housing codes when the work is complete.
4. Examples of work include roof replacement, new heat and air conditioning systems, insulation, rotten wood repair, and other Essential Repairs.
