


Public Meeting

Hyde County Flood Resiliency Plan

Thursday, June 8, 2016

12 PM to 2 PM Meeting and Feedback Session

The Hyde County Government Office and North Carolina Sea Grant have been exploring ways to make homes, farmland and infrastructure less susceptible to flooding. Progress on this work will be presented at a public Town Hall meeting on March 3. County residents are encouraged to come learn about Sea Grant and Stetson University's continued work to explore the costs and benefits of options for reducing flood damage that Hyde County Residents have asked them to study.

Sea Grant team members will present a draft of a Hyde County Residents' Flood Response Handbook, identified as a need during the project, for community feedback. The group will also discuss additional actions in preparation for Hyde County's Community Rating System (CRS) review in late 2016. Finally, they will ask for community feedback on the outline and content for a final project report on Hyde County Flood Resiliency Guidance.
