Registration for the 2020 Northeastern North Carolina Craft Workshop begins on February 7, 2020 and will be accepted on a "first-come, first-served" basis until March 25, 2020 deadline. Registration forms and class information can be requested from the *Hyale* County Cooperative Extension Service, phone *252-926-4486*

Registration fee is \$12 per day. All registration fees are non-refundable, but transferrable and must be received by March 25, 2020. Class Kit fees vary depending on class selection. The workshop is designed and open to everyone and anyone interested in learning a craft whether hobbyist, adult or youth groups, craft teachers, small business persons, etc.

The 2020 workshop will be held on May 12th and 13th at the Vernon G. James Research and Extension Center located at the Tidewater Research Station on NC Highway 32 in Plymouth NC. Hours are 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM daily.

Basketry: Woven Wearable Pouch or Small Basket with Wooden Base; Advanced Stained Glass Window; Wood Duck Decoy Carving and Painting; Basic Embroidery; Fly-Tying & Small Spinner Bate; Glass Etching; Beaded Ornament Cover; Copper Enamel Collage; Crochet for Beginners; Gourd Painting; Painting in Acrylic; Painting in Watercolor; Painting with Alcohol Ink; Polymer Clay; Reclaimed Jewelry Art on Velvet; Seagrass Stool Weaving; Silver Jewelry; YoYo panel; Quilting "New Hourglass."
