WHEREAS, on September 1, 2016 at 4:45PM I proclaimed a local State of Emergency for Hyde County with Mandatory Visitor Evacuation for Ocracoke Island, effective as of 4:45PM on September 1, 2016; and,

WHEREAS, I issue Proclamation – Termination of Mandatory Evacuation for Ocracoke Island on September 4, 2016 effective at 9:38 AM.

WHEREAS, I hereby terminate the Mandatory Visitor Evacuation for Ocracoke Island in Hyde County, North Carolina; and,

WHEREAS, I have determined that a State of Emergency still exists; and,

Now therefore, this proclamation is signed on this date, September 4, 2016 at 9:38 AM, and becomes effective at 9:38 AM on September 4, 2016.
