**WHEREAS**, I issue this proclamation entitled "Termination of Mandatory Evacuation Order Issued for Ocracoke Island," that becomes effective on October 17, 2016 at 5:00 AM.

**WHEREAS**, I hereby terminate the Mandatory Visitor Evacuation Order issued for Ocracoke Island in Hyde County, North Carolina; and,

**WHEREAS**, I have determined that a State of Emergency still exists; and,

**Now therefore, this proclamation is signed on this date, October 16, 2016 at 4:20 PM, and becomes effective at 5:00 AM on October 17, 2016.**
