### **Three Departures Added to Stumpy Point Emergency Route**

*Additional runs to be added to Pamlico Sound routes this weekend only*

**MANN'S HARBOR** — The North Carolina Department of Transportation's Ferry Division is adding three runs to the Stumpy Point-Rodanthe emergency route beginning Sat., Nov. 3. This brings the total number of runs each day to 10 from each side.

Dare County Emergency Management will open Hatteras Island to visitors starting tomorrow; and more departures are needed to assist with entry.

Those wishing to use the emergency route are reminded to expect long waits and to be patient, as priority status is still in effect.

The Stumpy Point-Rodanthe schedule will be as follows:

- Departing Stumpy Point at 5 a.m., 6:30, 8, 9:30, 11, 12:30 p.m., 2, 3:30, 5 and 9:30; and
- Departing Rodanthe at 6 a.m., 7:30, 9, 10:30, noon, 1:30 p.m., 3, 4:30, 6 and 7:30.
