Position: Public Health Education Specialist – Triple P Coordinator
(Hyde/Beaufort Triple P Collaborative) – **Reposting**

Salary Range: \$29,658 – \$37,814

Description: This position is a grant-funded position which is temporary and time limited based on the continual availability of grant funds. This position will serve as the Program Coordinator to implement the Positive Parenting Program (the Triple P System) initiative and supporting activities in Hyde and Beaufort Counties for families of children 0-5. The overall purpose of the program is to develop and deliver Triple P to providers in mental health, non-profit family services, court system, and private and public health systems. Triple P will target parents of children ages 0 to 5 as well as parents of children with developmental and/or intellectual disabilities. This position will serve as the liaison between Triple P America and the Hyde/Beaufort Triple P Collaborative.

Work Schedule: The hours for this position are generally 8:00 am - 5:00 pm Monday-Friday; however, these hours are subject to change based on the needs of the community and/or agency. Other hours required to work may include early morning, evening, and/or weekends. Travel will be frequent and will often extend the day.

Minimum Training and Experience: Graduation from a four-year college or university with a major in health education and one year of experience in public health education or a related field; graduation from a four-year college or university and two years of experience in public health education; or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Master's Degree preferred. Experience working with child health providers, child care providers, and families will be warranted.

Special conditions for employment: Prior to employment, the successful applicant will be asked to submit to pre-employment screenings. Applicants must possess a valid NC driver's license.
