JOB DESCRIPTION:

This position is responsible for performing professional social work duties investigating alleged abuse and neglect of children. Interviews all parties involved to substantiate allegations; assesses risks and determines custody provisions; develops treatment plans; documents cases and prepares reports. This position will also serve as an intake worker for all programs of the Hyde County Social Services on Ocracoke Island.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

Thorough knowledge of social work principles, techniques, and practices, and their application to complex casework, group work, and community problems. Considerable knowledge of a wide range of medical, behavioral, and /or psychosocial problems and their treatment theory. Considerable knowledge of family and group dynamics and a range of intervention techniques, governmental and private organizations and resources in the community, laws, regulations and policies which govern the program. Skills in establishing rapport with a client and in applying techniques or assessing psychosocial behavior, and psychological aspects of client's problem. Ability to supervise, train, or instruct lower-level social workers, students, or interns in the program. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with members of caseload and their families, as well as civic, legal, medical, social and religious organizations. Ability to express ideas clearly and concisely and to plan and execute work effectively.

MINIMUM TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

Master's Degree in Social Work from an accredited school of social work; Bachelor's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work and completion of the Child Welfare Collaborative (Child Welfare positions only); Bachelor's degree in social work from an accredited school of social work and one year directly related experience; Master's degree in a human services field and one year of directly related experience; Bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university and two years directly related experience; Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and three years of directly related experience.

OTHER REQUIREMENT:

Applicant must have a valid NC Driver's License and a reliable vehicle for travel. Applicant must reside or be willing to relocate in Hyde County.
