Jeannie is frequent visitor of Hyde County and a long time friend and student of MATTIE learning other crafts. Her popular stained glass art moves swiftly through our sales gallery.

A veteran student of stained glass coursework through Nash Community College, this will be Jeannie's first official teaching experience. Accompanying Jeannie to assist will be her own teacher, friend, and mentor, Mary Wells of NCC.

There are several steps in completing a stained glass project: cutting the glass, grinding the edges to match the pattern, foiling, soldering, washing and then, finally, waxing. To insure completion of your project in the allotted time, the first step (reserved for the intermediate workshops in spring) will have already been completed. In lieu of this step, Jeannie and Mary will perform a short cutting technique demonstration.

Total Cost for this one day workshop is \$100.00, half of which is materials cost. Maximum 6 students per session. Advance Reservations and pre-payment required. Call Judy McLawhorn at (252) 943-8991

Participants should wear an old shirt, bring gardening gloves to prevent cuts from handling glass, and a bag lunch. Everything else is provided. Portions of these workshops will be conducted in our new state of the art Down Draft Studio.
