



## **NOTICE TO OCRACOKE HOMEOWNERS**

Due to the impact of the current flood situation and in response to requests from local governments, The North Carolina Dept. of Emergency Management has extended the due date to May 15, 2017 for accepting applications for elevation, reconstruction or acquisition for properties that have experienced significant flood damage from Hurricane Matthew. Elevating your home can not only protect your home against future flooding, but can lower your future flood insurance premiums.

Hyde County Office of Planning will submit these applications to the Hazard Mitigation Program for funding. The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) assists state and local communities in implementing long-term mitigation measures following a Presidential Disaster Declaration.
